

Unsettling. Stressful. Invigorating. Right.

Ted and I have moved nine times in our marriage (39 years). Education, first call, second call, more education, new roles, on and on. Moving from one home (and town) to another is unsettling and stressful. Yet it is invigorating, too, and somehow right, if that decision fits with the larger hopes, dreams, and goals for our lives.

We may understand this *bigger picture* when we make a move, but that doesn't spare us from actually carrying out the plan, step by step by step —finding a new doctor, mechanic, grocery store, and walking path; setting up the utilities, internet, and trash removal. We can feel overwhelmed, even foundation-less while a major move is happening.

And, inevitably, when we make a move, something doesn't go as planned. For Ted and me, one purchase agreement just about fell apart as the moving truck was ready to pull out of the driveway. Many phone calls ensued! Moves are likely more expensive than you imagined, too.

Transitions between pastors in a congregation can have the same feel and stressors as changing houses. The level of actual details and tasks can be just as high, too. But when the transition is complete, the invigorating and satisfying sense of accomplishment and newness will come, once again.

Be patient, my friends, for there is no question that the calling of a new pastor fits with the larger hopes, dreams, and goals for First Lutheran Church (FLC). It is worth it. Together, we strive for the Gospel of Jesus to be lifted up continually among us. It is Jesus, by his Spirit, who gives new life and vitality to people and congregations alike.

For FLC and for any who are facing transitions personally, I offer a prayer from our faith heritage:

Prayer of Good Courage (from Holden Village)

O God, you have called your servants to ventures of which we cannot see the ending, by paths as yet untrodden, through perils unknown.

Give us faith to go out with good courage, not knowing where we go, but only that your hand is leading us and your love supporting us, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen


TLC WOW (Wild on the Word) Memory Work Presentations:


