FIRST Notes from Pastor Sara Ten Words that will Change Your Life

A new year has arrived, full of possibilities, changes, and adventures yet unknown. How might God be inviting us to begin it?

A lot may be changing in our church and world, but the foundations are not changing. The promises of God's faithfulness through the centuries and God's redemption in Jesus will not change, no matter the changes all around. When we lose track of these two promises, we can coach ourselves to return to the faith and teachings we have received, and then stand firm.

Standing firm, however, is not stillness and lack of action. Standing on God's promises is a lifetime of small choices and daily changes, often in our attitude, and usually away from quick, human assumptions and reactions.

Mid-way through Advent, verses from 1 Thessalonians 5 were our scheduled Scripture readings. I found myself returning to a phrase taught me long ago, by a high-energy speaker at a Christian retreat. As he coached us in faithful thinking and active faith, he said something like, "Do you know the ten words that will change your life?" I didn't then, but once I learned them, I haven't forgotten. They give guidance for the small thought choices we make each day in trusting God in each new circumstance.

I shared these ten words in a Wednesday worship service in December and I share them now, as we enter 2024, encouraging you to memorize them, and ask God to teach you anew what they may mean for your life, and for our life together as a faith family.

¹⁶Rejoice always, ¹⁷pray without ceasing, ¹⁸give thanks in all circumstances. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)

These ten words won't work the miracles within, for Jesus does that, but they will direct your attention, again each day, to God and his Holy Spirit's presence with us. Looking to God, trusting God, is what changes our lives.

We are God's people. You are God's child, marked with the cross of Christ forever. Let your light shine and let your heart be glad in Jesus, who gives new life.
