CHOICES and TALK

In one difficult moment of my life, when neither of my options seemed the obvious best, a wise person coached me, "Make your choice, *then* make it a good one." I knew there was wisdom in her words. They helped me take action, and then keep taking action to support that decision to the best of my ability.

The saying is true. Many juncture in life call for simply making your best choice and then embracing it faithfully moving forward. Not questioning, but committing. Again, and again.

In the call process at First Lutheran Church, many choices have been made by you and your leaders since you learned your senior pastor was retiring. Each time, the congregation has rallied to move forward

It will be up to you, to take your choice of this new pastor and *make it a good one*. It will be you that embraces the *getting-to-know-you* phase, the *first-hard-decisions* phase, and the *changes-for-the-better* phase. It will be you who add your support and energy, or hold it back.

It will be you who can season your speaking, your *talk*, here at FLC and *in the community*, with grace and kindness. It is you, with your words, who will help this new pastor be a well-received leader, and your church an honorable place, for all whom God is calling to be part of this church, or simply connected to it. By your actions. By your *talk*.

Some other helpful words in my life come from Colossians 4:5-6. They seem to apply here, for *great power lies in our words* when we're setting out to *make a choice, then make it a good one*.

Conduct yourselves wisely toward outsiders, making the most of the time.

Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt,
so that you may know how you ought to answer everyone.




